## **Hazard Mitigation Strategies:**

Full Body Harness: 3M DBI-SALA Delta III Construction-style Vest Harness; MSA Workman Full Body Harness; MSA TechnaCurv Full Body Harness; Sapsis ProPlus Basic Harness

Self-Retracting Lifeline: 3M Protecta Rebel 6' web Self-retracting lifeline

Horizontal Lifeline: 3M Sayflin Horizontal Lifeline System

D-Ring Extender: Condor Polyester D-Ring Extender

A visual inspection of all safety equipment will be done daily or before each use. Any defective equipment will be tagged and removed from use immediately. The manufacturer's recommendations for maintenance and inspection will be followed.
